Outline	The laboratory of Prof. Kotani at the Research Institute for Microbial Diseases, University of Osaka, studies infectious cancers using humanized mice. The laboratory is currently seeking a project member with a flexible attitude, who can conduct research using humanized EBV-infected lymphoproliferative disease model mice, as well as contribute to the development and enhancement of the research. The successful applicant will be responsible not only for research but also for managing the animal facility and for teaching at the liberal arts, undergraduate, and graduate levels.
