We are seeking a full-time Specially Appointed Assistant Professor who will engage in basic research on "inter-individual differences in serum bactericidal factors distinct from antibodies and the complement system" and "bacterial factors that adapt to these serum components." Applicants with experience or interest in proteomic and genomic analyses of these factors are particularly encouraged to apply.
